

Directions to Wilders Grove Away Football Games

APEX COUGARS

Apex High School - 1501 Laura Duncan Road - Apex

Travel US1 South to US 64 West. Continue 2 miles and turn left onto Laura Duncan Road. School is about 1/2 mile on the right.

BULL CITY LIONS

Neal Middle School - 201 Baptist Road - Durham

Take I-40 West to Miami Blvd. Continue on Miami Blvd about 4 miles. After crossing Hwy 70, the road becomes Sherron Rd. Go about 3.5 miles. At the stoplight, turn right on Hwy 98. Go 1/2 mile. School is on the left at the corner of Baptist Road and Hwy 98. (There is a sheriff station next to the field.)

CAPITAL CITY STEELERS

Carroll Middle School - 4520 Six Forks Road - Raleigh

Take I-440 North toward Outer Beltline/Wake Forest for about 4 miles. Take the Six Forks Rd. North exit 8B toward North Hills. Bear right onto Six Forks Rd. and go approximately 1/2 mile. The school is on the right, about three blocks up, at the corner of Six Forks and Rowan.

CARY (ALL CARY TEAMS)

Davis Drive Middle School - 2101 Davis Dr. – Apex

Take I-440 to US 1 South. Follow US 1 South to the Cary Parkway exit. Turn right on Cary Parkway. Turn left on High House Road. Turn left on Davis Drive. Go about 2 miles and the school is on the right. Go to the entrance for the middle school. **DO NOT PARK IN THE SCHOOL PARKING LOT.** Walk down the left side of the middle school on the driveway that goes past a baseball field to the football fields. Flag games are played on the soccer field on the right; tackle games are played on the football field on the left. There are no bleachers on the flag football field, so bring chairs.

CLEVELAND CHIEFS

West Johnston High School - 5935 Raleigh Road - Benson

Take I-40 East to exit #319. At the top of the ramp, turn left onto Hwy 210. At the flashing light, turn left onto Raleigh Road. The entrance to the school is a 1/4 mile down on the right.

DURHAM EAGLES

Lowe's Grove Middle School - 4418 S. Alston Avenue - Durham

Take I-440 North towards Outer Beltline/Wake Forest. Take exit 4B to I-40W/RDU Airport, and merge onto I-40W. Take NC-55 at exit 278 toward NC-54/Apex. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp and go to the 2nd traffic light. This is the intersection of Highways 54 and 55. Turn left onto 54 East. Go to the next traffic light and turn left onto Alston Avenue. The school is on your immediate left. Please do not park in the church parking lot. There is adequate parking on the opposite side of the school.

GARNER TROJANS

Garner High School - 2101 Spring Drive - Garner

Take 440 to exit 299 (Hammond Road/Person Street) to Garner. The road name changes to Timber Drive just before you get to Hwy 70. Cross through Hwy 70 intersection and turn left at second stoplight (Grovemont Road). Follow road past front of school and turn right into parking lot. School buses are parked near the entrance of the parking lot.

NORTH RALEIGH BULLDOGS

West Millbrook Middle School - 8115 Strickland Road – Raleigh

Heading North on Falls of Neuse Road, turn left onto Strickland Road. School is on the left.

ORANGE COUNTY

Cedar Ridge High School - 1125 New Grady Brown School Road – Hillsborough

Take 440W towards Wake Forest for 8.5 mi. Take exit 4B to I-40W towards Airport/Durham. Take Exit 261 towards Hillsborough. Turn right onto Old Chapel Hill-Hillsborough Rd./Old NC-86. Turn left onto Oakdale Dr. Turn left onto Orange Grove Rd. Turn right onto New Grady Brown School Rd.

AL STANBACK MIDDLE SCHOOL

3700 NC 86 SOUTH - Hillsborough

Take I-40 West to exit 263 (New Hope Church Rd). Bear right on New Hope Church Rd. At light, turn left onto Hwy 86 and head toward Hillsborough. Keep going until you see AL Stanback Middle on right.

SANFORD STING

Lee County Sr. High School - 1708 Nash St - Sanford

Take US1 South towards Sanford. Take Exit 74 (approximately 9 miles before you get to Sanford) and turn left onto Colon Road (which will become 7th Street). Turn right onto Bragg Street. School will be on corner of Nash Street and Bragg Street.

SOUTH JOHNSTON TROJANS

Take Interstate 40 East to exit 325. At the top of the ramp, turn left onto Hwy 242. Travel to the flashing light. Turn right onto Raleigh Road and travel about 1/4 of a mile (you will cross over the railroad tracks). Turn right onto Hwy 301 - the entrance to the school is on the left.

TRI-COUNTY PANTHERS

Chewning Middle School - 5001 Red Mill Road - Durham

Take I-440 W toward Wake Forest. Take US-70 W via Exit 7B towards Crabtree Mall/Durham. Take the I-85 N exit toward Petersburg/Henderson. Go 3.6 miles and take exit #182 Red Mill Rd. Turn left on Red Mill Rd. and go 2 miles. Chewning Middle is on the left.

WAKE FOREST TITANS

Wakefield Middle School - 2300 Wakefield Pines Drive - Wake Forest

Take US 1 North (Capital Blvd off of Beltline is US1). At the first exit/intersection marked for Wake Forest (Rte. 1A), turn left onto New Falls of Neuse Rd. (It will be across the intersection from Wakefield Ford and Chris Leith Chevrolet). Follow New Falls of Neuse for about a mile to the traffic light. Take a right onto Wakefield Pines Drive. You will be going up a hill. On your left is the YMCA, then Wakefield Elementary School. After the elementary school is Wakefield Middle School, also on your left. After you reach the parking lot, follow the drive around to the field behind the school. You may drop off your participants there and then park your car in front of the school. Bring your own chairs; seating is limited.

WILMINGTON

Wilmington Games are played at Ogden Park in Wilmington. Take I-40 East to Gordon Road. Ramp off and turn right on Gordon Road. Go approximately 3 miles. Turn left onto Ogden Park Road (across from the Kangaroo convenience store and just before the stoplight at the Eaton Middle School entrance). Go past the soccer fields, and the football complex will be on your right. There are three or four football fields there, and you will be directed to the correct one. Note: Wilmington handles its admission fee a little differently than we do-they charge \$ 2.00 per car, not per person. Some of the fields have bleachers on both the home and visitor sides, but some don't. You may want to take some chairs along, just in case.
